Access Award

PURPOSE

To honor and recognize an individual, corporation or organization that has demonstrated exceptional and innovative effort to provide enhanced access and to eliminate barriers to those who are visually impaired.

ELIGIBILITY

- Individual, Corporation or Organization doing business in New Hampshire
- Demonstrates a proactive approach in providing a product, program or service that enhances access for the blind and visually impaired.
- Serves a significant portion of the visually impaired or blind population in reducing inequities.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Nominations accepted in a one-page narrative format from any source submitted to Advocacy Committee Chair either electronically or written.
- Nomination letters must include nominees name and contact information, nominators name and contact information and one-page detailed narrative outlining how individual, corporation and organization have met the eligibility requirements.
- Access Award will be presented annually based on nominations received.
- Nominations accepted each year through September 1st.
- Award presented to recipient at mutually agreed upon place and time.
- Advocacy Committee will work with Association staff to determine appropriate publicity.
- Access Award also to include a recognition plaque of each year's recipient that hangs in the hallway at Future In Sight.
