What is DCMP?

DCMP makes educational videos accessible by adding captions for students who are deaf and hard of hearing, and description for students who are blind and visually impaired. This service is funded by the U.S. Department of Education, so all services are FREE of charge.

How do I get an account?

- Visit dcmp.org.
- Click "Apply for a Free Membership."
- Fill out the application form.
- Reply to the email verification message.
- Start using your free account.

What kind of media does DCMP have?

- Titles for early learners through Grade 12
- Titles for all academic areas
- Titles to promote health, safety, self-advocacy, and more
- Accessible television programs that entertain and educate

How do I access the media?

- Members can watch accessible media online, on mobile devices, on their home TV with a set-top box, or on DVDs shipped from the DCMP.
- Parents can create Student Accounts for use directly by students, who have access only to those videos for which the parent has granted permissions.
