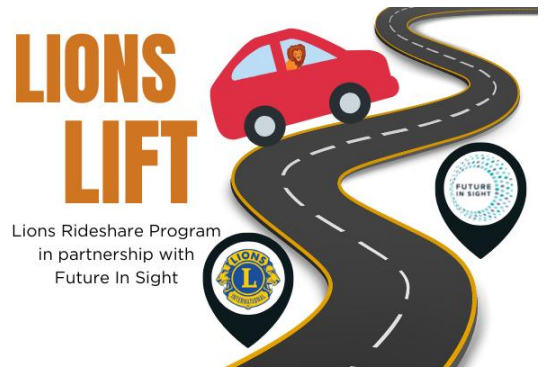


What is Lions Lift?

Lions Lift is an excellent opportunity to provide essential transportation for the blind and visually impaired people living in your community!

Lions Lift is a partnership with NH Lions clubs and Future In Sight's Volunteer Drivers program. It is a service project in each club's community which provides essential rides.



The Need...

Did you know that there are nearly 26,000 blind and visually impaired individuals in New Hampshire? Every Lions Club likely has many blind and visually impaired individuals who need essential rides in their community. Lions can make a difference with your help!

How It Works

- We connect Lion members and their clubs with the Blind and Visually Impaired in need through Future In Sight.
- All interested Lion participants register with the Future In Sight Volunteer Driver program.
- Future In Sight conducts an orientation and training so all participants feel comfortable and confident with the service project.
- Once all volunteer paperwork is processed including background checks, paid for by Future In Sight, participants are welcomed into the Lions Lift Program.
- Ride opportunities for your area are shared with you by the Future In Sight Volunteer Program Manager, Susanne Peace. You may choose which opportunities match your comfort and availability.
- Future In Sight will track the number of individuals served, miles driven and provide regular reports for each club pertaining to all their participating members.
