By opting in to receive SMS (text) messages from **Future In Sight**, you agree to the following terms and conditions. Our SMS program is designed to help you stay informed about our services, resources, and support for individuals who are blind or visually impaired.

Program Description

When you subscribe to our SMS messaging service, you may receive text messages related to:

- Appointment reminders
- Service updates or changes
- Educational events and program offerings
- Client support and care coordination
- Fundraising or volunteer opportunities
- Emergency notifications (e.g., weather-related closures)

Message frequency will vary based on your engagement with our programs but typically ranges from 2–4 messages per month.

Message and Data Rates

Standard **message and data rates may apply** as determined by your mobile carrier. Future In Sight is not responsible for any charges incurred from receiving or sending SMS messages.


Opt-Out Instructions

You may **opt out** of our text messages at any time by replying **STOP** to any message. Once you opt out, you will receive a confirmation message and will no longer receive texts from Future In Sight unless you re-enroll.
